# Undergraduate university study of Architecture and Urban Planning

Admission requirements in the 2017/2018 academic year



#### How many students are admitted to the study?

In the 2017/2018 academic year, **forty-five full-time students** financially supported by the Ministry of Science and Education shall be admitted to the first year of the Undergraduate university study of Architecture and Urban Planning.

#### Who meets the admission requirements?

The Undergraduate university study of Architecture and Urban Planning admits individuals who have graduated from a secondary school of a minimum duration of four years and who had at least two years of Mathematics as a subject matter in the course of their high-school education, and have passed the state secondary school-leaving exam (*državna matura*).

#### How are applicants selected?

Applicants for the Undergraduate university study of Architecture and Urban Planning are selected according to the points earned on the basis of:

- results achieved in the course of secondary education (grade point average for all four years of high school)
- results achieved on mandatory subjects of the state secondary school-leaving exam: candidates must have passed the required level of mandatory subjects of the state examination (the Croatian language, Mathematics, a foreign language), and the mandatory elective subject (Visual Arts)
- results achieved on an additional examination of skills knowledge (entrance exam).

#### What does the entrance exam consist of?

The additional examination of skills and knowledge assesses the candidate's abilities of visual expression and space perception, as well as the candidate's propensity for the study of architecture.

More specifically, the exam evaluates the candidate's graphic and visual skills, visual memory, perception skills, space perception, the ability to represent space by projecting it on a flat surface in collage or by means of a quick space model, or some other technique.

A test of the candidate's general predisposition for the study of architecture covers the knowledge of arts other than the visual (music, film, video, painting, sculpting, performance, conceptual art etc.), as well as the candidate's familiarity with the movements in design of the 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> centuries (from Futurism to Web).

The candidates are obliged to take this examination at an announced time, without receiving any prior notification. The date and time of the examination, the list of candidates and their arrangement in the Faculty's sketching rooms shall be announced on the Faculty's noticeboard and website <u>www.gradst.unist.hr</u>.

The examination is conducted at the Faculty of Civil Engineering, Architecture and Geodesy, Matice hrvatske 15, Split, Croatia.

All candidates must bring either their ID card or passport to the examination.

If the candidate does not arrive at the examination at the announced time, or if the candidate does not bring a valid identification document, he/she will be considered withdrawn from the examination process.

The candidate must take all parts of the entrance exam.

## How are secondary school results, the state secondary school-leaving examination results and an additional knowledge and skills examination evaluated?

## What can I do with a Bachelor's degree in Architecture and Urban Planning?

Holders of a Bachelor's degree in Architecture and Urban Planning can take up the following positions:

- Junior (assistant) urban planner
- Junior (assistant) designer
- Supervising civil engineer's assistant in jobs related to construction supervision
- Main site engineer/construction site manager (valid for buildings in C, D, E, F and G categories in addition to having passed the professional exam and a minimum of three years of professional experience)
- Site engineer (valid for buildings in C, D, E, F and G categories provided that one has passed the state professional exam and at has least three years of relevant engineering experience)
- Head of construction works (valid for buildings categorized in group H provided that one has passed the state professional exam and has at least three years of relevant engineering experience).



## Where and how can I apply?

All applicants apply via the National Information and Application System for Higher Education (NISpVU). Details of the application process will be given in the booklet that will be available in schools and on the webpages <u>www.postani-student.hr</u> and <u>www.studij.hr</u>.
