

Ante Mihanović, B.Sc. civil engineer, full professor at the Faculty of Civil Engineering in Split, was born on November 26, 1948 in Donji Sitno, Split municipality. He finished secondary technical construction school in Split in 1967, and graduated from the Faculty of Civil Engineering of the University of Zagreb in 1972. At the same faculty, he obtained his master's degree in 1977, and then his doctorate in 1981. Since the fall of 1972, he has been continuously employed at the current Faculty of Civil Engineering, Architecture and Geodesy in Split. Since 2001, he has held the permanent title of full professor, as well as the title of scientific advisor with ID number 030725. He is the founder and editor-in-chief of the international journal Engineering modeling from 1987 to the present day. So far, he has published 112 scientific papers, of which 6 in CC and SCI journals, 17 in other journals and 39 at international conferences. He is the author and co-author of 5 books. A narrower area of scientific activity is numerical modeling of the mechanics of building structures. He holds 10 patented inventions and another 15 patent applications. The area of patenting is prefabricated concrete and lightweight concrete constructions and elements. He was the supervisor of over 50 graduate theses, 7 master's theses and 5 doctoral theses.

In addition to scientific teaching, he also engaged in professional engineering activities, predominantly in the field of design in the country and abroad and revision of construction projects. He passed the professional exam in 1978. Since the very foundation of the Croatian Chamber of Civil Engineers, he has been its certified engineer. He is an authorized auditor of the Ministry of Environmental Protection, Spatial Planning and Construction, in the area of Mechanical Resistance and Stability, Energy Saving and Thermal Protection, and Noise Protection.

He performed duties in organizational activities; head of the institute for 10 years, vice dean for 2 years, dean for 10 years. He was a member of the Scientific Council of the Ministry of Science from 1990-1992. year and a member of the National Council for Higher Education in 1994-1998. year

He was awarded the annual prize for the development of the University of Split in 2007.

He is an associate member of the Croatian Academy of Sciences and Arts and a regular member of the Croatian Academy of Technical Sciences.
